

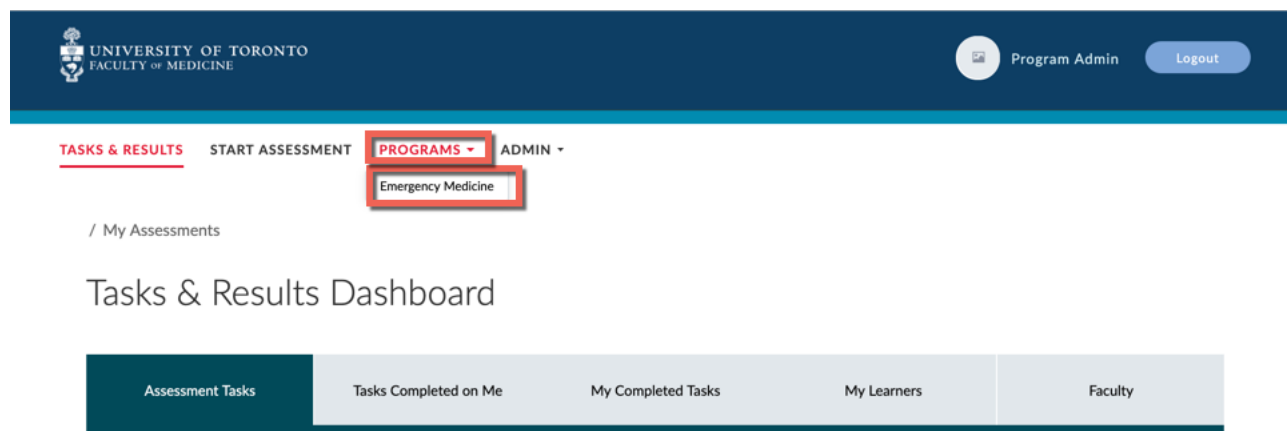
Elentra User Guide: Adding a URL to your CBME Dashboard – For Administrators

Objectives

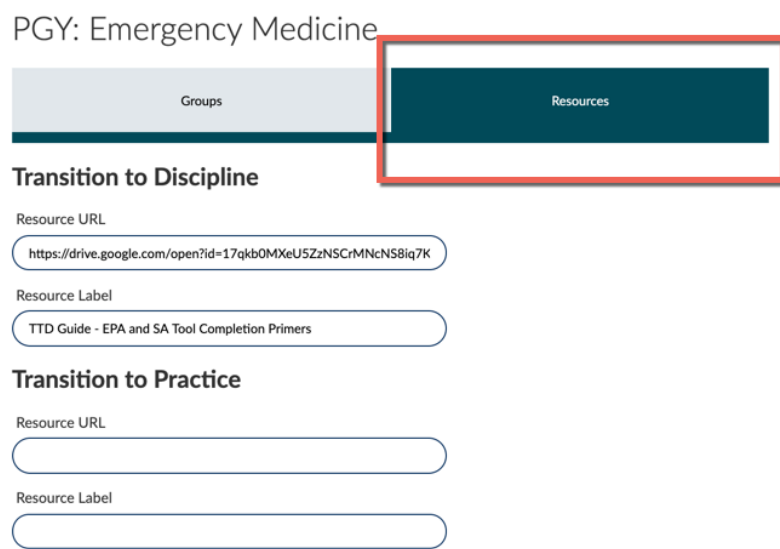
- a. Learn how to add a URL to your CBME Dashboard

The **Resources** feature in Elentra allows you to post a link to the Learners' CBME dashboard that may be helpful to them for completing assessments. For example, you may want to link to your program's curriculum and assessment map. This link is accessible to all Learners in your program.

1. Log in to **Elentra** using the following website: <https://meded.utoronto.ca/>
2. Navigate to *Programs* → Find & Select your Program Name



3. Select the *Resources* tab



4. Add the URL to the *Resource URL* text field

Add the label you would like displayed to the *Resource Label* text field. For example, TTD Guide
