MEDSQUARES USERGUIDE #3: Recover Forgotten Password

WELCOME to medsquares:

For 2017-18, residents (i.e. Learners) and faculty (i.e. Assessors) in programs that are set to launch CBD will be using the University of Toronto online assessment platform called medsquares for completing CBD assessments.

A. Access your PROGRAM-SPECIFIC Site

1. Go to your residency program's medsquares site: http://cbme.usquaresoft.com/

B. SELECT "Forgot password?"

2. Select the "Forgot password?" button located at the bottom center of the login page



C. Recover Password

3. Enter the email address associated with your medsquares account. A recovery link will be sent to this email addresses inbox.



D. Select Recovery Link

4. Click the recovery link you received in your inbox to set up your new password.
